How to bid on WCN's e-auctions

Login and password

To participate in WCN auctions, you must have an account on the wcn.pl website and use the email and password from the WCN website for authorization.

If you don't have an account, you can create one here: https://wcn.pl/auth/register

If you have already created an account but have forgotten your password, you can reset it here:


The email and password will work correctly only if they can be used to correctly log in to the WCN website. You can check them by logging into the WCN website here: https://wcn.pl/auth/login

Register for the auction


To sign up for the auction, click on the **Register for auction** button:



If you are not currently logged in with WCN data, a login window will open.



After correct logging in, a page with regulations and basic information about the auction will open.




Accept the terms and conditions and click the **Register for auction** button. For WCN E-auctions, the default spending credit is PLN **10,000**. If you need more, you will be able to submit a request for an increase after signing up for the auction.

Bidding

Bidding takes place on the page of each item. Enter the maximum amount and click the **Bid** button



On mobile devices, the bidding button is located at the bottom of the phone screen:



Bids are accepted only until the time specified for a given lot and it is not extended after submitting further bids. The bid for a given lot is won by the highest bid submitted before the countdown time expires. We recommend not to wait with the offer until the last seconds, because in the case of two identical offers, the order in which they are submitted determines the win.

Changing the credit limit

To send a request to change the credit of expenses, go to your profile by clicking on the icon with initials in the upper right corner of the screen:




Then find the current auction and click on it. Information about the auction and a form to submit a request for an increase in spending credit will appear.




My bids
